

Graduate Record Examinations® (GRE) Score Report: GRE's are offered through ETS (Educational Testing Services). Official records of your GRE results will be electronically sent directly to NAU when you list NAU as a recipient of those scores when you register for your exam. When having GRE scores sent to us, please use Institution Code 4006 and Department Code of 0620. GRE's are offered at a variety of sites; for dates and additional information, please visit their web site at www.ets.org/gre. Seating is sometimes limited, so make arrangements early to take your exam.

Applicants should take the GRE according to our posted timeline. Print out your unofficial scores as soon as they are available to you online through GRE (Quantitative and Verbal scores should be available as soon as you have completed the online exam). If you have not received your *official* scores by the time you e-submit your CSDCAS application, go ahead and enter the unofficial scores you do have and leave Writing blank. Your official scores will be sent to NAU Graduate Admissions directly from the GRE office.

Test takers can email questions to gre-info@ets.org or call (609) 771-7670. GRE scores up to 5 years old are accepted, with scores reported for Verbal, Quantitative, and Analytical Writing sections. If you took the exam within the 5-year time period but did not list NAU as a recipient, you can still have those scores sent to us by contacting the GRE center at 888-473-7267.

A new GRE exam format will be coming out in August 2011. The NAU Graduate College will implement an "overlap" policy for individuals who took the exam in the former format.
