**Description of Course:** The current CHM 152 course relies heavily on problem solving. This optional recitation course parallels the material covered in the CHM 152 lecture. The concepts of lecture will be demonstrated and discussed and students will participate in various problem solving exercises.

All CHM 152 students are welcome to attend the recitation session regardless if they are enrolled. However, if a student officially enrolls in the recitation section above, the course is for one hour of credit and is graded "Pass/Fail". Determination of the grade is based on attendance and participation. **YOU MUST ATTEND A MINIMUM OF NINE RECITATION SESSIONS** and "sign in" to ensure a passing recitation course grade. Enrollment in the recitation course and failure to attend will result in a failing grade.

Please refer to your CHM 152 course syllabus, the University Catalog, and the schedule of important dates in the 2009 Spring Class Schedule (on the web) for information on University academic policies and dates for dropping classes. CHM 152 lecture, the laboratory course CHM 152L, and the recitation course CHM 152R, are separate courses. Dropping CHM 152 does **NOT** automatically remove you from CHM 152L or CHM 152R.

**Notes:**

1. You may drop a course through the ninth week of the semester with the approval of your academic advisor. If you drop a course through the fourth week, the course is deleted from your permanent record; between the fourth and ninth weeks, a grade of W (withdrawal) is recorded. The university deadline to drop with a "W" is **Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup>**.
2. Remember, drop/add is not complete until it has been processed through the Registrar's office.
3. CHM 152, the laboratory course CHM 152L, and the recitation course CHM 152R, are separate courses. Dropping CHM 152 R does **NOT** automatically remove you from CHM 152 or CHM 152L
