2. Quality of the project design

- Activities are well planned and described in adequate detail.
- Activities advance the project in thoughtful and creative ways.
- Personnel are qualified to carry out their responsibilities.
- Plans for administration are sound.
- The letters from scholars, other consultants, and participants demonstrate interest and commitment.
- Evidence of commitment and support among the participating institutions is provided.
- Plans include appropriate evaluation and the letters from external evaluators demonstrate interest and commitment.
- The project budget is reasonable.

- The project will significantly enhance humanities teaching and learning.
- The results will be disseminated and made available to all interested users.
